



INDUCTION PROCEDURE

ELIGIBILITYCRITERIA

- 1. MBBS/BDS or equivalent degree from any institution recognized by Pakistan Medical Commission (PMC).
- 2. One-year Internship (House Job) with six months in Medicine and Allied and six months in Surgery and Allied disciplines for Medical.
- 3. One -year Internship (House job) in all six departments rotations (Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery, Orthodontics, Operative Dentistry, Prosthodontics, Periodontology, Oral Diagnosis) for Dental.
- 4. Valid PMDC permanent license.
- 5. Passing letter of Part 1 examination of FCPS/MS/MDS within last 3 years.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1. Commencement of residency program will be announced in newspapers along with last date of application form submission.
- 2. Then, application forms will be available in HR department and candidates will have to pay an amount of Rs. 1000/- with their applications
- 3. Candidates will be required to fill their forms completely.
- 4. Each candidate can apply for only one program hence only one application form can be submitted.
- Candidates can select any one track in Medicine/Surgery/Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery/Orthodontics (2-year or 4-year) and cannot switch to other track as per CPSP rules.
- 6. In case of a 2-year program, it is mandatory to mention the same sub-specialty as in CPSP application form.
- 7. After completing the application form, candidates will submit it along with all the required documents as mentioned on the form in the HR department, before the last date.
- List of documents include photocopies of CNIC, all educational documents including MBBS /BDS degree, House job certificates, valid PMDC registration certificate, FCPS I Congratulation letter.
- The candidate's information provided in the application form and documents shall be verified at either/all of the three (03) stages; During Application Processing, Time of Acceptance by the Teaching Institution, & During the Training.
- 10. If information submitted is found wrong, mismatched or forged, the application will be rejected and training, if started, will be discontinued with no right of appeal at institution / government level.

INDUCTION PROCEDURE

SELECTION PROCESS

- After the last date, all applications will be scrutinized, as per general eligibility requirements, by the Selection Committee and the short-listed candidates will be called for written test and /or interview.
- 2. Only short-listed candidates shall be contacted for further processing.
- 3. Candidates will be informed about test/interview date and venue through email and phone call, afterwards admit cards will be dispatched.
- 4. Candidates will be required to bring their Admit Cards at the test/interview.
- 5. Written test will include scenario-based multiple choice questions which will cover relevant topics and subjects adequately.
- 6. Interview will include interactions with Program Supervisors who would be testing knowledge and communication skills to evaluate the candidate as a safe and professional doctor.
- 7. Assessment Performa for all residents will be completed by respective Program Supervisors, based on their interviews.
- 8. Afterwards, Selection Committee will decide about the final selection of postgraduate trainees in their respective programs.
- 9. Only the selected candidates will be contacted by HR for joining via email and phone call.
- 10. Post-Graduate Residents will give their joining at the hospital and joining report shall be signed by the Supervisor/Program Director and Head of the Department. The candidate will submit the copies of the joining report to the HR and then apply to the CPSP/DAI for registration or enrolment.



POLICIES AND PROCEDURES



ASSESSMENT PROCESS:

- Residents will be assessed according to the CPSP rules.
- Supervisors will provide ongoing, informal, verbal feedback to the Residents required by the programs.
- If a problem is identified at any point during an Educational Experience or any component of a Resident's training the Supervisor will bring the problem to the attention of the Resident in a timely fashion, preferably in person. This must be documented and forwarded to the Program Director who will provide additional support as needed.

ASSESSMENT POLICY:

Assessment will be done on the basis of:

- a) Evaluation form
- b) Biannual theoretical Exams
- c) Biannual OSCEs
- d) Clinical performance
- e) Academic sessions performance
- f) Dissertation/Thesis/Report of a research project done by the Residents
- g) Oral presentations
- Each resident must receive a feedback biannually/quarterly.
- The performance review will be conducted by the supervisor.
- If a resident has any objection/ reservation on his assessment result, he can appeal to Program Supervisor for resolving the issue. If it remains unresolved, then he can forward his request to the Chair of PG committee, for further processing, that may include discussion and/or re-assessment, in order to seek resolution of dispute.
- It will be mandatory for all trainees to attend both CPSP and institutional workshops

LEAVES AND TRANSFER POLICY:

Leave Duration:

- a) For FCPS programs, maximum of four weeks of leave shall be allowed during one calendar year.
- b) For MCPS programs, maximum15 days leave will be allowed every six months. Break in training/ Freezing of program:
- a) Break in training shall only be allowed after completion of two years training and IMM/mid-term evaluation.
- b) Freezing of program shall only be allowed for six months, once in whole program and after formal approval from CPSP / University.
- c) Institutional approval will be granted by Chair of PG committee, after discussion with the Supervisor/ Program Director.
- d) If the candidate fails to join after 6 months, his training will be terminated.
- e) In case of any uninformed break in training or change of supervisor or institution, a trainee will be penalized with six months of deficit/ additional training, to be completed at the end.
- f) The trainee will also has to submit an affidavit that he will not conduct any further break in train ing, otherwise his training will be terminated with no further relief.
- g) If a Postgraduate Trainee applies for freezing, his/her original documents will be submitted to the institution to ensure his/her continuation of training.

Maternity Leave:

- a) In case of female PG residents, maternity leave of 90-days with pay/salary will be given only once during the course of training and the leave period will be completed as deficit at the end of training.
- b) For further maternity leaves, candidates will have to do the deficit and complete the prescribed duration of training.

Leave for Hajj:

- a) Leave for Hajj will be only once and for a period not more than 45 days during the entire residency tenure.
- b) All Postgraduate Trainee who will avail leave for Hajj must undergo additional training to complete training requirements.

Transfer Policy:

- a) No transfer/change of groups of specialty or straight fellowship shall be allowed.
- b) In case of any such circumstances, it should be in accordance with CPSP/ University regulations and its approval/rejection will be entertained accordingly.

GRIEVANCE POLICY

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this policy is to enable Post-graduate Trainees of Darul Sehat/ Qamar Dental Hospital to be able to voice their concerns regarding matters related to training and work ultimately resulting in improvement in the training programs and working environment itself. This policy should seek to resolve the grievances raised by Post-graduate trainees and/ or their trainers by investigations and recommendations.

SCOPE:

This policy is meant for Post-graduate Trainees of Darul Sehat / Qamar Dental Hospital training programs.

A grievance may be defined as a concern or complaint which a Trainee has regarding his or her terms and conditions of training and/or training relationships. Examples of possible complaints that may be raised in this regard by a Trainee may include:

- a) Unfair treatment by any Senior (Supervisor, Head of department, Senior Trainee) or Colleagues.
- b) Unfair treatment by Hospital staff or patient's attendants'
- c) Significant deficiencies in training resulting as a consequence of:
- Assignment of duties
- Rostering arrangements
- Granting study leave
- Access to protected training time
- Access to courses and protected time (personal)

PRINCIPLES:

The following principles apply to all stages of the grievance procedure:

- A Darul Sehat / Qamar Dental Hospital PG Trainee should, where possible, raise complaints on an informal basis with the senior resident or registrar on the floor in the first instance before proceeding to activate the formal grievance procedure.
- Complaints irrespective of their nature once received will be treated as confidential by the Grievance Committee

• Darul Sehat / Qamar Dental Hospital will deal with a grievance in as confidential manner as possible. However, in some circumstances, it will be necessary to disclose the content of a grievance to third parties – for example, where that grievance has the potential to adversely impact another person; they are entitled to fully understand any allegations made against them. DarulSehat/ Qamar Dental will consult the complainant before sharing information about the grievance with other parties. DarulSehat/ Qamar Dental Hospital will retain information about the grievance on the complainants personnel file.

• Every effort will be made to address complaints quickly and fairly. While every effort will be made to adhere to the prescribed time limits, these may be extended at any stage where necessary.

a. Time limit for initial address of the grievance : 7 days

- b. Time limit for arrangement of a formal response (in person) for trainees grievance :15 days
- A DarulSehat / Qamar Dental Hospital Trainee will not be penalized for making a complaint in good faith, regardless of whether the complaint is upheld or not.
- Before initiating the grievance procedure, the complainant should consult the policies and procedures relating to training of DarulSehat / Qamar Dental Hospital todetermine if a pathway to resolution has not already been defined and can beutilized by the Trainee. Should the complainant not be sure how to proceed the complainant may contact DARUL SEHAT/ QAMAR DENTAL Postgraduate Training incharge/supervisor or Education office for guidance.
- The grievance procedure is not an appropriate mechanism for a Supervisor/ Head of Department to address alleged shortcomings in the Trainee's work standards, conduct or attendance.
- A Trainee may also address decisions relating to the training program via the mechanisms to Reconsider or Review a Decision under the Appeals Policy.
- The raising of a grievance does not excuse a person in any training program from carrying out their contractual obligations to participate in the Training Program. A person raising a grievance has the right to be accompanied by a colleague throughout the process albeit this companion will not act as a spokesperson or advocate for the complainant. In certain limited circumstances the choice of companion may not be allowed.

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POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

EXIT POLICY FOR PGS OF DSH AND QDH

- If a trainee gets admission, but he/she does not give consent and does not join, he/she will exit the program without penalty.
- If a trainee gets admission and he/she does give consent, but does not join, he/she will exit the program with the penalty of being debarred from applying in the next induction.
- If a trainee gets admission, gives consent and joins and exits the program within six months without any approval by the Administrative Department. He/she will be debarred from applying in the next three induction programs & will refund whole stipend earned during the period of training.
- If a trainee joins and then leaves without informing, after more than six months and before completion of training, He/she will be debarred from applying in the next three induction programs and experience certificate will not be issued to him/her.
- If a trainee gets admission, joins and exits and then applies for leaving the program, his case will be presented and processed by the institutional PG Committee, which may decide to penalize the candidate or otherwise. Penalty will be in the form of debarring the trainees for applying in the induction.
- All PG Trainees have to leave the training slot on completion of training tenure irrespective of their status of examinations.
- If a Postgraduate Trainee wants to complete his/her remaining Postgraduate training in another province on wedlock basis, he/she may be allowed "Exit" from training along with experience certificate after approval from PG Committee, subject to the provision of necessary documents i.e. marriage certificate, spouse domicile.
- Issuance of experience certificate: resident will be eligible to apply for experience certificate and exit from the respective Program, if he fulfills following criteria:
- a) Completes tenure of training without any deficits (2-year/4-year)
- b) Attends all mandatory workshops
- c) Completes all rotations, as per requirement of CPSP/University
- d) Completes log book
- e) Submits synopsis/dissertation, if required
- f) Satisfactory annual assessment
