## **Mastery in Dentistry: Case Reveals**



#### Case by: Prof. Dr. Attiya Shaikh & Dr. Sadaf Talha

Patient named Narmeen, MR No. 075812 age 20 years and 7 months reported to the orthodontic department with a chief complaint that "My teeth are prominent and they are not meeting properly". On clinical examination, she had a hyperdivergent, brachycephalic head, mesofacial face type with a convex profile, and incompetent lip seal along with tongue thrusting habit. On evaluation of the records, she had skeletal class II and dental class I with anterior open bite of 5mm and bilateral posterior cross bite of upper 456. She had crowding in upper and lower arches. Her upper midline was on with facial midline and lower midline was shifted to right by 1.5mm. She was treated with habit breaker followed by upper fixed expansion appliance to relieve tongue thrusting and bilateral posterior cross bite respectively. Fixed mechano-therapy with all first premolar extractions. Anchorage was reinforced in both arches. The case was finished in a class I incisor, canine and molar relationship followed by fixed retention in upper.

#### **ORAL HEALTH AWARENESS**

#### **Oral Lichen Planus**

Oral lichen planus (LIE-kun PLAY-nus) is an ongoing (chronic) inflammatory condition that affects mucous membranes inside your mouth. Oral lichen planus may appear as white, lacy patches; red, swollen tissues; or open sores. These lesions may cause burning, pain or other discomfort.

Oral lichen planus can't be passed from one person to another. The disorder occurs when the immune system mounts an attack against cells of the oral mucous membranes for unknown reasons. Symptoms can usually be managed, but people who have oral lichen planus need regular monitoring because they may be at risk of developing oral cancer in the affected areas.

#### Location

These lesions may appear on the:

- Inside of the cheeks the most common location
- Gums
- Tongue
- Inner tissues of the lips
- Palate

#### **Appearance**

The lesions may appear as:

- Lacy, white, raised patches
- Red, swollen, tender patches
- Open sores

#### Pain or discomfort

The white, lacy patches may not cause discomfort when they appear on the inside of the cheeks. However, symptoms accompanying red, swollen patches and open sores may include:

- Burning sensation or pain
- Sensitivity to hot, acidic or spicy foods
- Bleeding and irritation with tooth brushing
- Inflammation of the gums (gingivitis)
- Painful, thickened patches on the tongue
- Discomfort when speaking, chewing or swallowing




#### Dr. Naggash Ismail wins 2<sup>nd</sup> position at The Pakistan Association of Orthodontics (PAO)
